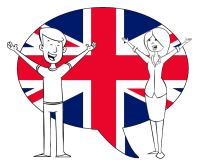

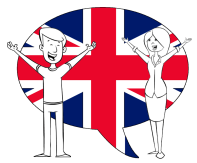

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BETONUNG - WORT + SATZ

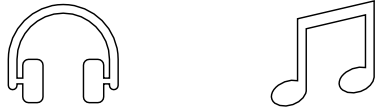


WORT

Es gibt einige Regeln für die **Betonung von Wörtern**, welche **Silbe** betont werden soll.

Aber leider sind die Regeln ziemlich kompliziert!

Wahrscheinlich lernt man am besten aus Erfahrung.



Hören Sie sich das gesprochene Englisch genau an und versuchen Sie, ein **Gefühl für die "Musik" der Sprache** zu entwickeln.

Aber **2 kleine Tipps** haben wir noch:

1 - **Ein Wort** kann lediglich **eine Betonung** haben.

Wenn Sie zwei Betonungen hören, dann hören Sie zwei Wörter.

he**l**lo

2 - Wir können **nur Vokale** betonen, jedoch **keine Konsonanten**.

SATZ

Die **Betonung des Satzes** gibt der englischen Sprache ihren **Rhythmus** oder "**Takt**".

Satzbetonung ist die **Betonung bestimmter Wörter** innerhalb eines Satzes.

Die meisten Sätze bestehen aus zwei Grundtypen von Wörtern:

Inhaltswörter = Schlüsselwörter eines Satzes

Die wichtigen Wörter, die die Bedeutung/Sinn - den eigentlichen Inhalt - tragen.

Stellen Sie sich vor, Sie erhalten diese Telegrammnachricht:

park **car** **garage**

Grammatikalisch falsch, aber wahrscheinlich verstehen Sie die Nachricht.

Struktur-Wörter = keine sehr wichtigen Wörter

Wörter, die den Satz grammatikalisch korrekt machen. Sie geben dem Satz Struktur.

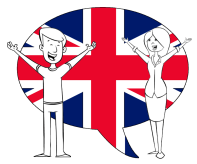

FEHLER 1

Heteronyme auf die gleiche Weise aussprechen

Heteronyme Wörter werden gleich buchstabiert, aber haben eine andere Bedeutung.

Zum Beispiel schreibt man "read" für die Gegenwart und Vergangenheit.

Jedoch ist die Aussprache unterschiedlich.

FEHLER 3

"TH" nur auf eine Art aussprechen

Die englische Silbe "TH" hat zwei verschiedene Aussprachen.

oder **stimmlos** (ohne Stimmbandvibration) ausgesprochen werden - pa**th**

Einfach **Finger auf die Kehle** legen und sehen, ob man Vibrationen spüren kann.

FEHLER 4

Aussprache von "-ed" (Simple Past) am Ende von Verben

Die Aussprache von "-ed" bestimmt die Endung der Grundform (Infinitiv) des Verbs.

Grundform endet auf "d" oder "t"

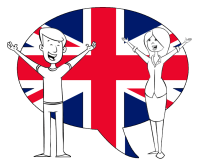
Grundform endet auf "f", "k", "p", "s", "sh" oder "ch"

SATZBAU



Die **englische** Sprache **unterscheidet** sich im Satzbau etwas von der **deutschen**.

Sie ist außerdem **nicht so flexibel**, d. h. die **Satzglieder** können nicht beliebig im Satz ausgetauscht werden und haben somit in der Regel ihren **festen Platz**.

Der Satzbau folgt grundsätzlich der Regel "**Subjekt - Prädikat (Verb) - Objekt**" (**SPO**).

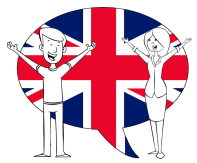

Personalpronomen

gibt es einmal in der Subjektform als Stellvertreter für ein Subjekt und in der Objektform als Stellvertreter für ein Objekt.





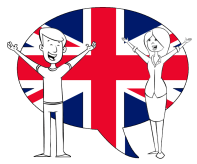
Es gibt keine Höflichkeitsform im Englischen.

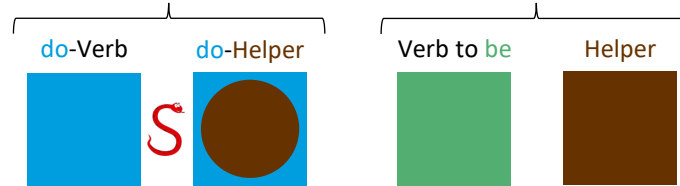
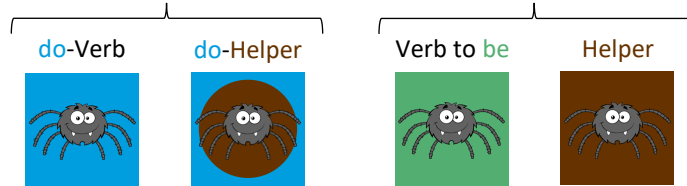

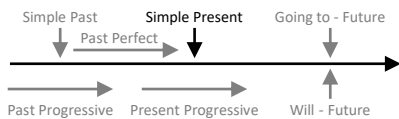
Will-Future

Mit dem **Past Progressive** drücken wir aus, dass etwas zu einem **bestimmten Zeitpunkt** in der Vergangenheit **gerade passiert ist** oder **getan wurde**.

Das **Present Progressive** (auch als **Present Continuous** bezeichnet) wird benutzt um das **was gerade passiert** zu beschreiben.

Das **will-Future** benutzt man für **Spontane Entscheidungen**, **zukünftige Ereignisse** (unabhängig eigener Entscheidungen), **Vermutungen** und **Versprechen** über zukünftige Ereignisse.

Leider lassen sich Präpositionen meist nicht 1:1 übersetzen. Da hilft nur, in einem Wörterbuch nachzuschlagen.

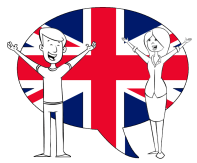

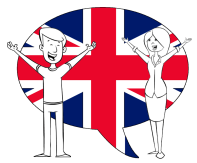

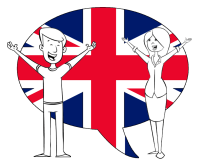
